How does Inclusive Access, or IA, benefit you?

Inclusive Access, or IA, is a program where eBooks and digital content is sent automatically to you or before the first day of class. Generally these materials will be available directly in the Canvas site for your class. IA is a fraction of the cost of printed materials and eliminates the need to shop for textbooks. It also makes it easier to add and drop classes at the last minute and still have the course materials you need.

Do I have to use Inclusive Access, or IA to purchase my course materials?

No. You have the option of purchasing them separately by opting out of the IA program. To opt out, please email optout@rappahannock. edu by the last day to drop your class. Because materials are generally cheaper through the IA program, before you opt out verify with your instructor that the materials you are purchasing elsewhere include all the access codes, software, and ebooks needed for your course. Is this a new program?

You may have used the Follett Access program with our previous bookstore. The Inclusive Access program is nearly identical. If you have other questions about whether inclusive access is right for you, please contact your Navigator.

How do I pay for Inclusive Access?

IA is billed along with your tuition and fees, so when you pay your account balance (or your Financial Aid is applied to cover your tuition and fees) your IA costs are paid at the same time.
